



We are grateful to be a part of the preparation of Energy Audit Report of Dr. B.K.B. College, Puranigudam, Nagaon, Assam for the year 2020-21 (from 1st July, 2020 to 30th June, 2021). As a part of audit methodology, we have visited Dr. B.K.B. College, Puranigudam, Nagaon, Assam campus on 14th July, 2021 to collect data and to take some instantaneous measurements. We have studied the present energy consumption pattern, assessed the actual operating load, illumination study and energy conservation in lighting system. The summary of the Report is as follows -

- The average monthly energy consumption of the college campus is 952.23 units.
 Annual bill is Rs. 187863/ Average unite rate is Rs. 7.35/-(Grid Power)

- 4. Cost of Generator fuel for the year 2020-21= Rs. 28263/-
- 5. In all, ten solar streets light are installed inside the campus. Installation of a solar plant is suggested.
- 6. Only five star rating air conditioner should be used.
- Remaining twenty percent of the tube lights used should be replaced by LED lights.
 Energy monitoring and maintenance mechanism including DG set performance should be further streamlined. The operational staff must be given comprehensive training and awareness should be created among students and staff for efficient use of electricity and safety precaution.

We, hope that this activity will improve the energy efficiency and reduce the overall energy consumption of the College campus.
