**COVID-19 PANDEMIC INDUCED CHALLENGES
AND OPPORTUNITIES IN COLLEGE EDUCATION**



Now if you ask a question to a college student 'In which Year or Semester do you read', he will be confused to give a clear answer. Students are reading in Second Semester, appearing examination of First Semester and likely to be promoted to Third Semester. This is the situation now, of course created by the pandemic. Students are out of campus for a long time and when the normalcy will come it is uncertain. The government and universities have been trying to minimize the academic loss.

The pandemic creates havoc in all spheres of human lives and in college education as well. It shows us human inabilities in front of natural disasters. It creates unbelievable situation which could not be dreamt of even a few months earlier.

Anyway, the Covid-19 situation brings some challenges to college education. Students and teachers are out of campus though they have online connection. Face to face contact is necessary for fruitful collegiate education. Students are losing direct guidance of teachers and learning from peer teams through physical presence. Some of the students are even facing psychological problems for long time confinement at home. As the situation is purely new the college, university and civil administration sometimes find it difficult to handle.

On the other hand, some new opportunities are coming out of it. Online mode of education was long awaited but now becomes very popular and fruitful during the pandemic. Teachers and students are compelled to use the latest online teaching-learning devices. The university authorities also have no alternative out but to go for online mode in conduct of various students related activities including examination. Open Book Examination System which was less discussed and used to meet the crisis. Though these devices and systems are premature now these will be hopefully more accurate and popular in time. Online devices have become more smart and cheaper. We had to spend a couple of lakhs to purchase Online Video Conferencing system. Earlier to connect only two or a few points, strong internet connection and devices were also needed. But now various cost-effective video conferencing devices are available in the market through which hundreds of people could be connected round the globe. Most of these online systems will remain useful and effective in future also even after the pandemic situation is over. UGC's suggestion to cover 40% of syllabi through online system has now made it within the reach.

Human civilization has been facing and overcoming many crises. We will be capable to face and overcome this crisis also. Let us learn from this crisis and take benefit out of it.
