From the Desk of Principal

One of the best practices of Dr. B.K.B. College is publication of a yearly news bulletin named Khabarnama. This is a very important documentation of the college which reflects yearly plan, activities and progress- scholastic as well as non-scholastic of all stakeholders mainly students and staff members of the college. This publication is usually released by the end of every year or NAAC AQAR session.

The academic Year 2024-25 of the college is remarkable for many activities and achievements. The college administration and academic fraternity were busy almost throughout the year for integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) related works as the college is in the process of introduction of the ITEP B.A. B.Ed. (Secondary 1 Unit). Number of students is also increased as far as enrollment of the college is concerned, but student dropout rate also alarmingly increased. Results in Higher Secondary and under graduate programmes are comparatively satisfactory. Analysis of the results is done on regular basis at our institution. Now I feel that analysis of student dropout rates in higher education institutions(HEI) particularly of rural and semi urban areas is also equally very important.

I think a few crucial factors are involved for alarming increase of dropout rates at our institution. First, poor economic condition of a student is an important cause. Secondly, drastic increase of educated unemployment rates in our state is another cause. Thirdly, a section of the students, particularly male students are not interested in traditional higher education programmes like B.A., B. Com, B.Sc. etc. Same are the causes with other rural and semiurban colleges of Assam for increased rate of college dropouts.

Nowadays activities of a government college of the state increased manifold. A good number of activities are undertaken or conducted on the basis of Government order or instructions over and above normal works and duties usually performed at the college. Sometimes the academic administrator or principal finds it difficult to maintain a good academic environment after observance of many activities/divas/anniversaries/functions at the institution level. Some of the celebrations or observances are without doubt necessary, but it is very challenging to attract the students to the classes, libraries and books.

It is also noteworthy that importance is given to numbers or data generated instead of standard or quality of academic environment maintained by a higher education institution or a college. Marks or grade still matters most at an educational institution in India. It is hoped that National Education Policy 2020 introduced all over the country will be able to overcome most of the challenges which are hindering the progress of higher education sector in the country. During the last six seven years our institution under the affiliating university was also passing through many changes and reforms introduced in the state and national levels. I think we have successfully survived these challenges and our institution is on the right track of development. Next year we are going to celebrate Diamond Jubilee Year of the College and it is a matter of pride to celebrate the growth of an institution.
