



ITEP B.A.-B.Ed. Admission Policy

- Dr. B.K.B. College, Puranigudam has officially launched its 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) B.A.-B.Ed (Secondary Stage) for the 2026-27 academic session. Located strategically adjacent to National Highway 127 (NH-127), the campus offers excellent transit communication, making it highly suitable and accessible for students commuting from nearby regions. Students with a low-budget for expenditure as well as preferring a premier Govt. NAAC "A" graded Institution, Dr. B.K.B. College is a right choice for them.

Admission Policy Overview

- **Seat Intake:** The College has a strict, NCTE-approved capacity of exactly 50 seats for this batch B.A.-B.Ed. (Secondary Stage).
- **Entrance Exam:** Candidates must have appeared and qualified in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026 conducted by the NTA.
- **Application Platform:** Eligible candidates must apply online through the centralized Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (SAMARTH Portal) within the stipulated time.

Government Rules & Regulations

- **Merit-Based Shortlisting:** Seat allocation and counselling are strictly handled according to Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Govt. of Assam guidelines via the SAMARTH ranking system.
- **Reservation Policy:** Mandated statutory reservations for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST (P), ST(H), EWS, and PwD categories apply seamlessly as per state government norms.

Tie-Breaking Policy for Merit Lists

When managing admissions via the SAMARTH portal, in the event of two or more candidates securing the exact same NCET 2026 score/percentile, the inter-se merit rank for admission will be determined sequentially by the following tie-breaking rules:

1. Higher marks/percentile obtained in the Teaching Aptitude section of the NCET 2026.
2. Higher aggregate percentage scored in the Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent qualifying examination.

Major and Minor Subject Allocation

The B.A.-B.Ed. is a dual-degree professional program where students select Major and Minor subjects (e.g., History, Political Science, Education, Assamese).

Securing admission to the ITEP program does not automatically guarantee allocation of the candidate's first-choice subject.

Subject combinations will be allocated during the physical counseling process based strictly on the candidate's NCET merit rank, subject eligibility criteria, and the intake capacity of the respective academic departments.

Required Documents for Verification

Candidates must produce the following documents at the time of counseling:

Printed copy of the submitted SAMARTH Portal Application Form.

NCET 2026 Scorecard and Admit Card.

Marksheets and Pass Certificates of Class 10 (HSLC) and Class 12 (HS) examinations.

Age Proof Certificate (Class 10 Admit Card or Birth Certificate).

Valid Caste / EWS / PwD Certificate issued by the competent authority of the Govt. of Assam (if claiming reservation).

Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) or Identity Proof.

Mandatory Anti-Ragging Undertaking

Dr. B.K.B. College maintains a zero-tolerance policy toward ragging. In compliance with the UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, every student and their parent/guardian must submit a mandatory Anti-Ragging Undertaking/Affidavit online in the prescribed format at the time of final admission.

General Note:

Preference will be given to students who selected our Institution as first choice and on the basis of merit in the preparation of Merit List. If eligible applicants are not available under a particular reserved category the vacant seats will be considered converted to the Open Category and filled up on merit basis during scheduled period of Spot Admission. Admission will be final subject to verification of original documents.

Admission fees once paid will not be refunded.
